Today, Richcroft employs more than 630 dedicated staff members and has been recognized as a Top Workplace by both *USA Today* and *The Baltimore Sun*. We are proud to support more than 370 individuals with IDD through a broad continuum of services designed to meet people where they are and help them move toward where they want to be. At Richcroft, support is never one-size-fits-all; it is personalized, person-centered, and grounded in respect.



Our Residential services include 57 homes located throughout Baltimore, Howard, Harford, and Carroll Counties, each offering safe, supportive environments where individuals can build skills, relationships, and independence. Beyond Residential Supports, Richcroft provides Community Day Services, Personal Supports, and Shared Living options – ensuring flexibility, choice, and continuity of care as people’s needs and goals evolve over time.

To further strengthen the quality of care we provide, Richcroft established Richcroft Nursing and Clinical Services. These programs enhance the medical and clinical supports available to those we serve while also extending our expertise to partner agencies throughout the region. This investment reflects our unwavering commitment to whole-person care – supporting not just daily living, but health, wellness, and long-term stability.

In 2025, Richcroft took an exciting step forward by relocating our Executive Offices to a St. John Properties location in Sparks, Maryland. This move allowed us to create a new Day Hab program space intentionally designed for meaningful engagement, creativity, and skill-building. The space includes a Snoezelen Sensory Room, a State-of-the-Art Training Kitchen, a Sports Simulator, and an Artist Studio complete with a kiln - each thoughtfully designed to support learning, expression, and personal growth. These environments are more than rooms; they are opportunities for discovery, confidence, and connection.
